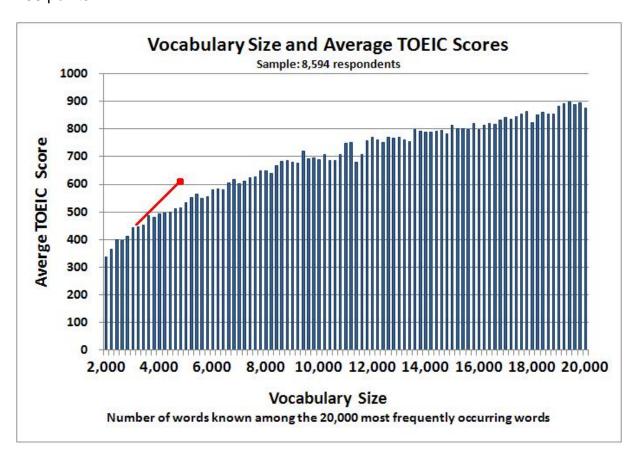
Word Engineers Get Ahead Faster!

The Word Engine learning system is a game changer. In just one semester, students who study 40 minutes a week can expect to see TOEIC score increases from 100 to 250 points.



This graph shows the correlation between TOEIC scores and initial V-Check test scores for 8,594 respondents. In this graph, all learners having, for example, from 4,000 to 4,099 known words are represented together as one blue bar and the average of their TOEIC scores is 485.

The red line illustrates the Word Engine advantage. Rather than randomly acquiring new vocabulary, each 'Word Engineer' focuses on just their missing high frequency words for TOEIC. In this example, starting from 3,100 general words, the learner added 800 new TOEIC-specific words and scored 165 points higher on their next TOEIC. Students not using Word Engine would need, on average, 1,800 new words to achieve the same 165 point score increase.
